TRAIL: Rated 1A, Suitable for strollers but not wheelchairs. The walk takes you through the historic area of town, two pre-Revolutionary War cemeteries, a former Civil War Confederate Prison Camp cemetery (now a National Cemetery) and through city parks. It is mostly on city sidewalks and park pathways. Restrooms and refreshment opportunities are available along the walk route. “A” award available.

HOW TO GET THERE: From I-85 exit 76. You will be on E. Innes St. Travel west 9/10 mile to Lee St. V.C. is on right (NE corner), one block before Main St. – the city center or “The Square”. **Parking:** Free lot one block from V.C. at Depot and Council Streets.
